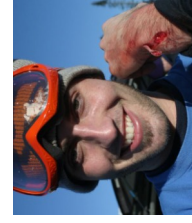


are you ready?

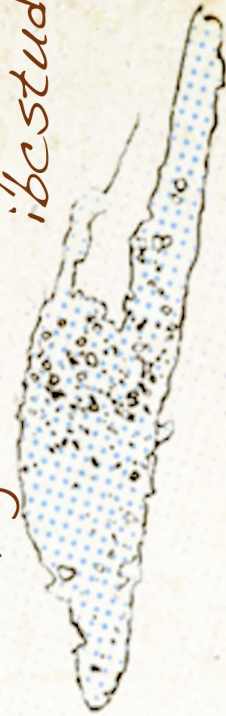

3. Everyone is to be in their room at the stated times.
4. Consumption of alcohol, smoking, and use of illegal drugs is prohibited.
5. Personal Electronics are not permitted (i.e. ipods, games, DVD, etc) Cell phone use should be MINIMAL!
6. Modest clothing is expected.

In cases of participants not abiding by this code of conduct parents may be called. Discipline matters will be handled by adult staff. Students will be sent home if necessary at participant's expense.
